"Spiritual Sequels"

A few years ago I finished a thousand page historic novel, one of the best reads in that genre I'd come across. So engaging was the story with layered plots and protagonists that by the time I finished, I was sad. The author had drawn me in. He had woven a tantalizing tapestry of medieval life and lore that so pulled me in and held me in stimulated suspense, that by the time the last word of the last page was read, I grieved its conclusion, the sense of loss at its ending. And then...I found out there was a sequel. The story would live on. Different characters but still rooted in the past ones, while building a new but still connected future.

I've reflected on this as part of our Oakwood story comes to an end. I am saddened. Mike Fillmore and Nick Peters have been a part of this congregation's "story" for three years. While we knew the end was inevitable, there has been, nonetheless, a sense of grief accompanying this part of the narrative. It has been a good three years, filled with laughter and tears, with inspiration and challenges. We are the better for having had them with us. I like to think they are the better for their association here, as well.

But amidst the sense of loss is also a growing reality that has ever been Oakwood's mantle and mission: there is a sequel! We embrace new opportunities to develop and integrate new colleagues into a ministry designed to love, accept, forgive and encourage in God's abundant grace. The "story" that is ours will continue. "Different characters but still rooted in the past ones, while building a new but still connected future."

Like the writing of well crafted book, please pray for discernment in the process of inviting new "characters" into our narrative, a narrative that has now lived for twenty-five years and is postured for transforming service in the decades ahead. Our spiritual sequel continues. While we look back with deep appreciation upon the gifts we've had in the recent and distant past, we also look forward to the Holy Spirit's story through us as new servants are called to Oakwood. May all of us rededicate, anew and afresh, for God to make our lives like "the hand of a ready writer" (Psalm 45:1).






NEW STUDY STARTING SOON THE LIFE YOU'VE ALWAYS WANTED
